- CAP-CAN Liaison** – Liaisons are designated by the leadership of their organization, and serve as the key point of contact for CAP. The Liaison receives information from CAP on what's possible, then helps to turn those possibilities into reality. Liaisons work closely with the leadership of their organization to gain approval for ideas, and keep the leaders and members informed about issues affecting the family. They receive CAP emails and pass along practical ways to stay informed and involved. Liaisons coordinate and supervise voter registration twice per year. Prior to elections, they distribute *CAP Voter's Guides*. Liaisons may also consider many other ideas for activism, including: creating a Community Impact Group (Civic Awareness Group), maintaining a CAP display at their organization, or leading a *Truth Project* small group. Liaisons can encourage other members to sign up as CAP-CAN Local Activists; these activists can assist with special projects, like voter registration drives. CAP STATEMENT OF FAITH

As a religious organization, The Center for Arizona Policy is permitted and reserves the right to select volunteers on the basis of religion. All District Coordinators, District Members and Church Liaisons must hold principles that coincide with The Center for Arizona Policy's Statement of Faith.

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God.
