- Subscribers to *Family Facts-Arizona* will periodically receive a *CAP Action Alert*, giving you an opportunity to take action on a current issue. We encourage you to respond and forward it to others to take action.
- Let your legislators know what you think about issues they are considering, because your voice makes a big difference. "Find Your District" and "Find Your Legislator" by visiting the Voter Registration box in the bottom right column at www.azpolicy.org.
- It's important to have the right people serving in government and therefore your vote is important. You can register and encourage others to register to vote at www.azsos.gov (click on button at the bottom of the page on the right side). It's also important to encourage our family and friends to get out and vote on Election Day.
- You can hold a voter registration drive. For information to help you plan a drive, visit CAP's Voter Registration Center at www.azpolicy.org/voterreg.
- Prior to elections, distribute our nonpartisan *Voter's Guide* that presents the candidate's positions on several important issues related to the family and our faith.
- Join our Prayer Network by visiting www.azpolicy.org and clicking on "Prayer Ministry" in the right column and then under "Prayer Opportunities" in the right column, click on "Weekly Prayer Email."
