[1] Abortion; Live Delivery; Report; Definition (SB 1367) - Strengthening Arizona's law to ensure babies born alive following an abortion are provided life-saving care. **Passed House 32-22-4. Passed Senate 18-11-1. Signed into law by Gov. Ducey on March 31, 2017.**

[2] End-Of-Life; Discrimination; Prohibition (SB 1439) - Prohibiting work-related discrimination against health care providers that exercise their conscience rights by declining to provide medical care that could cause or assist in causing the death of an individual. **Passed House 32-24-4. Passed Senate 17-13. Signed into law by Gov. Ducey on March 24, 2017.**

[3] Health; Budget Reconciliation; 2017-2018 (SB 1527) - The budget provision requires the AZ Department of Health Services to apply for Title X monies, and distribute monies received to health care facilities that are owned or operated by this state or any political subdivision of this state, hospitals and federally qualified health centers, rural health clinics, and health care providers whose primary area of practice is the provision of primary health services enumerated in 42 United States Code section 254b(b)(1). **Passed House 34-25-1. Passed Senate 17-13-0. Signed into law by Gov. Ducey on May 12, 2017.**

[4] Empowerment Scholarships; Expansion; Phase-In (SB 1431) - Expanding the Empowerment Scholarship Account program to include all district and charter school students by phasing in eligibility over the next four years. **Passed House 31-28-1. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Signed into law by Gov. Ducey on April 6, 2017.**

[5] Governmental Entities; Diplomas; Transcripts; Recognition (HB 2389) - Requiring all governmental entities to treat all Arizona school diplomas and transcripts equally, including homeschool diplomas and transcripts. **Passed House 41-17-1-0-1. Passed Senate 20-10. Signed into law by Gov. Ducey on April 18, 2017.**
