[1] *Partial-Birth Abortion Ban – HB 2400*: Prohibits partial-birth abortion in Arizona.  
**Passed House 37-19. Passed Senate 20-8. Signed by the Governor. (CAP-Supported Bill)**

[2] *Abortion Consent Act – HB 2564*: Updates Arizona's abortion statutes regarding the rights of parents whose minor daughter faces an unplanned pregnancy, the informed consent rights of a woman considering an abortion, and the civil rights of health care professionals not to participate in abortion.  
**Passed House 36-19. Passed Senate 16-12. Signed by the Governor. (CAP-Supported Bill)**

[3] *Ban on Non-Doctors Performing Abortions – SB 1175*: Clarifies that Arizona law does not permit an individual who is not a licensed physician to perform a surgical abortion.

**Passed House 35-19. Passed Senate 16-11. Signed by the Governor (CAP-Supported Bill)**

[4] *Jesse's Law, Part 2 – HB 2616*: Protects a patient who is unable to communicate his wishes and who does not have a written health care directive by modifying Arizona's laws governing when food and fluid can be withheld from a patient.

**Passed House 52-1. Passed Senate 21-7. Signed by the Governor. (CAP-Supported Bill)**

[5] *Charitable Tax Credit Simplification - HB 2286*: Simplifies and adds accountability to the state tax credit for donations to charities serving low-income residents.

**Passed House 55-1. Passed Senate 16-13. Signed by the Governor. (CAP-Supported Bill)**

[6] *Scholarship Tax Credit. – HB 2288*: Ensures that the corporate tax credit program that provides scholarships for children to attend private schools as chosen by their parents continues beyond 2011.

**Passed House 33-23. Passed Senate 16-12. Signed by the Governor. (CAP-Supported Bill)**

[7] *Withholding Tax Reduction - HB 2287*: Enables employees to have their withholding tax reduced and contributed to the scholarship, school activities, and charitable tax credit programs.

**Passed House 33-20. Passed Senate 18-9. Signed by the Governor. (CAP-Supported Bill)**

[8] *Students' Religious Liberties Act - HB 2357*: Codifies court rulings into state law clarifying that students in public schools have constitutional rights to express their religious beliefs.

**Passed House 37-23. Passed Senate 18-10. Signed by the Governor. (CAP-Supported Bill)**

[9] *Lexie's Law - HB 2001*: Creates a new corporate and premium tax credit for donations to scholarship tuition organizations providing scholarships to disabled and displaced students.

**Passed House 35-25. Passed Senate 17-11. Signed by the Governor. (CAP-Supported Bill)**
