SENATE AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1394

(Reference to printed bill)

1 Page 3, between lines 20 and 21 insert:

2           "Sec. 2. Section 36-2162, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4           36-2162. Complications; reporting requirements

5           A. A health professional who provides medical care or treatment to a  
6 woman who, in the good faith judgment of the health professional, is in  
7 need of medical care because of a complication or complications resulting  
8 from having undergone an abortion or attempted abortion must file a report  
9 with the department of health services on a form prescribed by the  
10 department. The report shall not identify the individual patient by name  
11 but must contain the following information and other information as the  
12 department may require:

13           1. The date of the abortion.

14           2. The woman's age.

15           3. The number of pregnancies the woman may have had before the  
16 abortion.

17           4. The number and type of abortions the woman may have had before  
18 this abortion.

19           5. The name and address of the facility where the abortion was  
20 performed.

21           6. The gestational age of the unborn child at the time of the  
22 abortion, if known.

23           7. The type of abortion performed, if known.

24           8. The nature of the complication or complications , INCLUDING AT  
25 LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

26           (a) SHOCK.

- 1                   (b) UTERINE PERFORATION.
- 2                   (c) CERVICAL LACERATION REQUIRING SUTURE OR REPAIR.
- 3                   (d) HEAVY BLEEDING OR HEMORRHAGE WITH ESTIMATED BLOOD LOSS OF AT
- 4                   LEAST 500 CUBIC CENTIMETERS.
- 5                   (e) ASPIRATION OR ALLERGIC RESPONSE.
- 6                   (f) POSTPROCEDURE INFECTION.
- 7                   (g) SEPSIS.
- 8                   (h) INCOMPLETE ABORTION RETAINING PART OF THE FETUS REQUIRING RE-
- 9                   EVACUATION.
- 10                  (i) DAMAGE TO THE UTERUS.
- 11                  (j) FAILED TERMINATION OR PREGNANCY.
- 12                  (k) DEATH OF THE PATIENT.
- 13                  (l) OTHER.

14                  9. The medical treatment given.

15                  10. The nature and extent, if known, of any permanent condition

16                  caused by the complication.

17                  B. The hospital or facility shall complete the complication report,

18                  which may be signed electronically and shall indicate that the person who

19                  signs the report is attesting that the information in the report is correct

20                  to the best of that person's knowledge. The hospital or facility must

21                  transmit the report to the department within fifteen days after the last

22                  day of each reporting month.

23                  C. Any report filed pursuant to this section shall be filed

24                  electronically at an internet website that is designated by the department

25                  unless the person required to file the report applies for a waiver from

26                  electronic reporting by submitting a written request to the department."
